Drilling Update

Longford Resources Limited (ASX: LFR) (**Longford** or the **Company**) is pleased to update the market on the progress made at the Company's Keel Zinc Project in Ireland (**Keel**). In order to accelerate the drilling program at Keel, the Company now has two drill rigs active on site. Currently two holes of the initial 12 hole program have been completed, with the core sent to ALS Ireland for assay. The Company will update the market once final assay results have been received.

A detailed ground gravity survey is also in progress. The gravity survey is part of a geophysics program that will expose Keel to modern exploration. The survey will highlight areas for exploration targeting, denote key structural features and assist with interpretation of geology.

Loyalty Option Issue

As announced on 27th May 2017, the Company intends to undertake a pro rate bonus issue of Options. The record date is now 31 July 2017 for eligible shareholders of the Company who hold shares at the new proposed record date and will be granted one (1) free Bonus Option for no consideration for every three (3) shares held in the Company. The Bonus Options will be exercisable at a price of 5 cents (\$0.05) and will expire on the date that is twelve (12) months from the date of issue.

The Company notes that this record date is indicative only and the actual record date is still to be determined in accordance with the ASX timetable for a bonus issue.
